## **BEHAVIOR CONTRACT**

After repeated attempts to correct any inappropriate or unlawful behaviors, a Behavior Contract will be initiated. Corrective steps for this are listed below:

First offense: Student is referred to the office to meet with administrator. Appropriate incident report will be completed and placed on file. Loss of privileges may occur. Parents/guardians may be informed by telephone.  Second offense: Appropriate incident report will be completed and placed on file. Loss of privileges will occur. Parents will be contacted to schedule a meeting with parents, student and administration to list actions to be taken by all parties involved. Student will be put on a Behavior Contract.  Third offense: Appropriate incident report will be completed and placed on file. Strike 1 on Behavior Contract. Student may be suspended from school for a determined period of time. Parents contacted, loss of school privileges, law enforcement called in to meet with parents and involved students on school grounds, as needed.  Fourth offense: When no change is evident in students' behavior, expulsion from the school may occur. Parents will be given notification in writing, the reasons for removal and the right to request a hearing will be explained.
